SEASON 2004/5 ALLOCATION

The allocation for season 2004/5 will be announced in the first week of November as previously advised. Rainfall and run-off have again been low and we do not expect that the allocation will be more than last year.

Harvey Water will hold public meetings in early November with Harvey and Waroona irrigators to explain the allocations and to provide an update on progress with piping proposals, trade and so forth.

WELLINGTON DAM SALINITY

A circular sent out recently by Mick Murray MLA, Member for Collie, announced that the Federal and State Governments had approved the funds needed to get work going on reducing the salinity in Wellington dam.

The project is now nearing the end of the design phase, with input from Harvey Water. The biggest issue from now on is the tight timelines to get it fully organised and operating before winter 2005.

We look forward to better days ahead for Collie River district irrigators.

PIPE PROJECT

With the re-election of the Coalition, Harvey Water is actively following up the Prime Minister's offer of funding for the piping project. At the same time our lines of communication with WA water agencies remain open so that we get the best outcome for Harvey Water shareholders.
