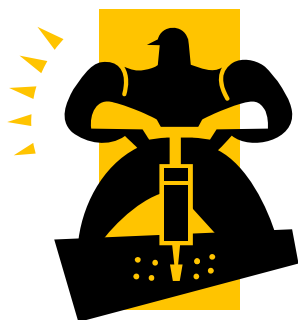

Annual Reports for both SWIAC and SWIMCO are now available and can be collected from the office. Alternatively, they will be available on the Harvey Water website from 5th September.

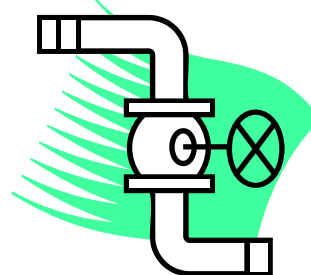
STOCK WATER ORDERS

GOOD NEWS FOR WELLINGTON DAM SALINITY

Some early data on the Collie River Salinity Recovery Project has shown positive results. The pumps are working and up to 21.6 ML/day of increasingly saltier water has been diverted to date. All indications are that we be able to measure a reduction in the salinity of the dam this year which is great news for Collie irrigators!

UPDATE ON PIPE PROJECT



The Harvey Piping Project is moving forward, with construction still anticipated to begin next month. Tenders have been called for pipes and installation, and various project plans including safety, risk management and quality plans are close to completion. A lot of consultation with various stakeholders has been held however further public consultation will be carried out.
